N.E.O exercise is operational success

The Frankfurt Military Community Non-Combat Evacuation Order Exercise conducted on February 7, 8, and 9, 1982 was an operational success. The exercise started on Sunday morning at 9 a.m., and by the end of the day 87 percent of the housing area and personnel living on the economy had had their NEO kits checked. By the end of the exercise 99 percent of the personnel had been inspected.

However, many shortcomings were discovered.

In most cases the families were given a completed copy of the checklist annotating the shortcomings in their NEO kits. It is the sponsor's responsibility to insure that his or her family's NEO kit is complete, and that the family is knowledgeable of its location and contents.
